Life History of the child and the reason for sponsorship:

The 1959 occupation of Tibet was followed by the exodus of about 80,000 Tibetans along with their spiritual leader His Holiness The Dalai Lama to neighboring countries like India and Nepal etc., which is where a large part of the current Tibetan Diaspora exists. For a refugee community on a foreign land, education is of key essence, which is why under the guidance of His Holiness and against all odds, Tibetan schools were established to provide proper education to the children in order to make them self reliant, to serve the Tibetan culture and identity. The Department of Education (DoE), CTA is the apex body, responsible for administration of Tibetan schools in exile. STS Lobersing is situated at Phuntsokling Tibetan settlement in Odisha. On 16th May 1999, DoE formed an organization, namely; Sambhota Tibetan Schools Society (STSS), responsible for managing the schools which were erstwhile managed by DoE directly. STSS persist on providing a holistic education to the underprivileged children, residing at the remotest area, who are bereft of their basic rights.

Dhashel comes from a humble family. Her mother is a house wife and her father is a teacher. The big family of eight members relies solely on the salary of the father. However, the income generated through his teaching is very minimal for such a huge family and it is already very difficult for the parents to manage the livelihood of the children, let alone their future. Dhashel's father wants her to be persistent in her effort to achieve a brighter future through good education and decent living and hopes for a miracle to happen.

Tenzin Dhashel is a well mannered girl who is very bright. She likes reading books during her free time. Her favorite colors are red and pink. Her favorite meal is rice and dal. Her favorite subjects are Tibetan and mathematics. She aspires to become a responsible doctor in the near future.
