Life History of the child and the reason for sponsorship:

The 1959 occupation of Tibet was followed by the exodus of about 80,000 Tibetans along with their spiritual leader His Holiness The Dalai Lama to neighboring countries like India and Nepal etc., which is where a large part of the current Tibetan Diaspora exists. For a refugee community on a foreign land, education is of key essence, which is why under the guidance of His Holiness and against all odds, Tibetan schools were established to provide proper education to the children in order to make them self reliant, to serve the Tibetan cause and to preserve the Tibetan culture and identity. The Department of Education (DoE), CTA is the apex body, responsible for administration of Tibetan schools in exile. STS Gothangaon is an exile Tibetan school, which was established in the year 1972 soon after the establishment of Tibetan Norgyeling Settlement. On 16th May 1999, DoE formed an organization, namely; Sambhota Tibetan Schools Society (STSS), responsible for managing the schools which were erstwhile managed by DoE directly. STSS persist on providing a holistic education to the underprivileged children, residing at the remotest area, who are bereft of their basic rights.

Tenzin Tseyang comes from a humble family where the sole breadwinner is her father. Her mother is a house wife and her father works as a driver and earns a meager amount. The salary of Tseyang's father makes it very difficult for the whole family to make their ends meet. Her father is concerned about her future and though he is firm about working very hard for his children, he is afraid that his salary will not be enough to support Tseyang's higher education. He does not wish for his low income to obstruct her dreams in anyway and hopes for her to expand her knowledge and utilize her skills to its utmost potential to fulfill her goals.

Tseyang is a sweet and lovely girl who loves reading books during her leisure time. Her favorite color is red and her favorite subject is Tibetan. Her favorite foods are momo (Tibetan dumpling) and noodle (thukpa). Little Tseyang has a high ambition of becoming a good teacher one day. She aspires to become a teacher who can facilitate people and help them grow.

On agreeing to the noble cause of sponsoring a child, Sambhota Tibetan Schools Society will keep the kind sponsor duly updated on the life and the progress of the child, twice a year. Your kind help will encourage and enable these underprivileged refugee kids in playing an instrumental role in the development of their community.
